Ages 4 - 9

Book: Where Oliver Fits by Cale Atkinson

Instructions:

Print out activity sheet on cardstock paper, or, glue onto a thin cardboard once printed.

Colour in puzzle pieces in all different colors - use other mediums such as glitter, stickers, buttons, pompoms and sequins to add layers.

Cut out your puzzle pieces and put your puzzle together! **Bonus:** Find a small box to store your puzzle pieces so they can be a reusable activity.

Skills:

Fine motor skills

Example: Colouring with different tools - crayons, pencils, and markers - to develop find and gross motor skills.

Understanding Emotional Expressions

Example: Does this puzzle piece look grumpy? Happy? Silly?

Key Element: This activity is designed for children who are encountering group settings that are causing peer pressure. It focuses on individuality, unique talents, and finding out how you fit into groups and different settings while still maintaining a sense of self. While moving through this activity, talk about how much happier Oliver is when he decides to be himself rather than fitting in with others.
